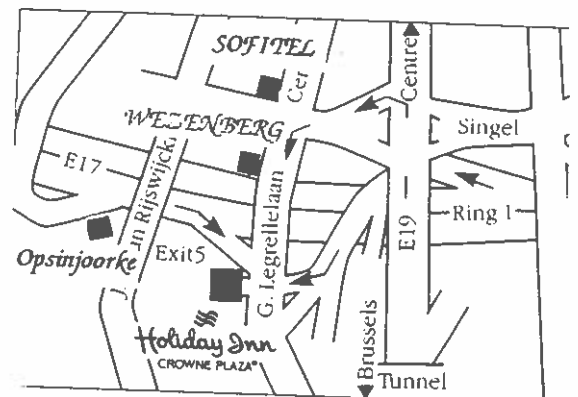
# AT THE EVENT.

## THE VENUES.

### Olympic Pool Wezenberg.

The Olympic Swimming Pool Wezenberg is situated in the heart of Antwerp, only a few miles from the old city centre. The Wezenberg is a 50 metre, 8 lane pool and has a separate warming up pool measuring 21m by 17m. It hosted several times the Belgian Swimming Cup and the EJC 1991.

Public transport to the ancient historic Centre of Antwerp is available nearby the venue. Meet hotels are within walking distance (100m) from the swimming pool.



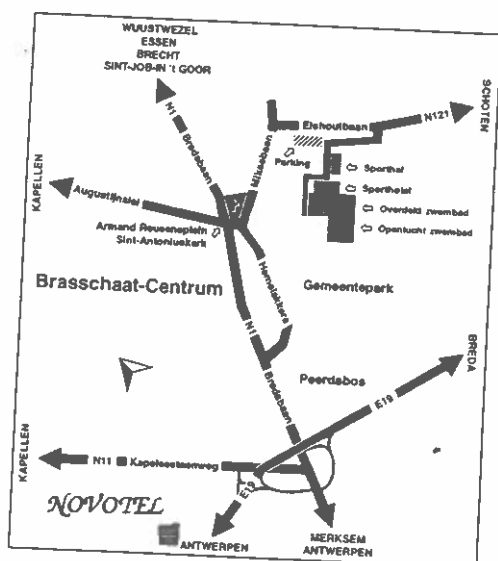
### Sport Centre of Brasschaat.

The diving competition will take place in the Sport and Recreation Centre of Brasschaat. This beautiful residential village lies 10 kilometre to the north of Antwerp City Centre.

The facility has a separate diving pool and will benefit from new Maxiflex springboards and resurfaced platforms. The facility consists of:

- 2 springboards Maxiflex C 1 metre,
- 2 springboards Maxiflex C 3 metre,
- 5m, 7,5m and 10m platforms.

This Sport and Recreation Centre played host to the European Swimming and Diving Championships 1991.



Visitors have also a 50m Olympic Swimming Pool, a familypool and a 77m long slide at their disposal.
