VI WORLD SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS MEDIA ACCREDITATION

HOW TO APPLY

Attached are application forms for Media Accreditation to the VI World Swimming Championships to be held in Perth from 3-13 January, 1991.

Accreditation, in categories, will only be granted to BONA FIDE members of the media.

Applications will be authorised and categories determined by a specially constituted Media Committee.

Special conditions will apply to material photographed, filmed or recorded.

The Media Categories will include:

- 1. Journalists;
- 2. Radio and TV broadcasters;
- 3. Still photographers;
- 4. TV Cameramen;
- 5. Support staff and technicians.

All forms must be signed by the applicant and Chief Executive of the organisation being represented and be accompanied by a letter signed on company letterhead by the Chief Executive of the organisation being represented.

All applicants approved for Media Accreditation will be officially acknowledged.

ACCREDITATION CARDS will be issued on arrival in Perth as per the official acknowledgment.

Media will be required to produce BONA FIDE IDENTIFICATION for collection of accreditation credentials.

The order of priority will be strictly in accordance with AIPS rules.

NOTE: CLOSING DATE for return of Media Accreditation Application Forms is Friday, 12 October, 1990.

MEDIA INFORMATION

Host Broadcaster — World Rights — radio, television or film (including stills) of the VI World Swimming Championships are owned by FINA (Federation Internationale de Natation Amateur).

Official Media Hotel information is attached.

Official Transport for Media Personnel will be effected to and from official Media Hotels and the Venues only and to/from airports on arrival/departure.

Telecom Australia Communication Services details are attached.

Media Centre

The Media Centre is located at the Superdrome in Sports Hall 2 and will be open from 26 December to 14 January and will contain the following areas:

1. Reception:

Information desk and administration with clearly marked shelves for results sheets. Results and Distribution Centre.

2. Promotion Office:

Media Centre Duty Manager.

Telex machine, photocopier and newspaper files.

3. Working Area:

Desks, typewriters, phones, computer points, facsimile machines, TV monitors, individual rooms for International and National Agencies, and results service.

4. Photographic Laboratories:

Adjacent to Media Centre. Cater for C41, E6 and Black and White processing and printing, Picturegram facilities.

5. Lounge Area:

Relaxation area with refreshments; TV monitor.

Media Stands

Positions at all venues. Photocopier service to each venue serviced by runners.

Photographers

All accredited photographers will be provided identification for entry to restricted areas. After the victory ceremony, winners will parade around pools.

Interviews

Interview room available adjacent to swimming competition pool for major events.

All arrangements are as per AIPS guidelines.

Long Distance Swimming Event

A media boat will operate for reporters and media facilities will be available at the Start/Finish area.

Other Information

Please note that the Western Australian electrical system supply is 240 volts, 50 hertz (cycles) alternating current. Electrical outlets take three pin, flat pin plugs. Transformers can be purchased in Perth, the cost varying with the capacity of the equipment.

Banking, post office, travel agency facilities will be available at the Superdrome venue.



6TH WORLD SWIMMING CHAMPIONSHIPS PERTH WESTERN AUSTRALIA 3 - 13 JANUARY 1991

GENERAL OVERVIEW

Telecom Australia is providing an advanced PABX telephone system for the championships with approximately 400 telephone and fax extensions connected. All media extensions will be controlled by a personal identification number allocated to each of the accredited media. This PIN number will allow access to the external telephone network (including interstate and international) and will allow the charging of all calls to the PIN number user. A media centre card will be provided at accreditation that will detail how to use the telephone and fax facilities.

For those media personnel using laptop computers and modems, Telecom Australia will provide an Australian standard telephone socket. Please check with the Australian Telecommunications Regulatory Authority (AUSTEL) on telephone 03 8287300 or fax 03 8203021 the compatability of your equipment to the Australian telephone network.

All telephone, fax and telex services provided by Telecom Australia for the World Swimming Championships will be free of charge with the following exceptions.

- 1. All call charges from telephone and fax services provided for the media will be charged to your PIN number. Telex services and charges will be controlled by the media centre manager. Call charge prices will be set at a fee to be determined by the World Swimming Championships Organising Committee. Payment of call charges should be made by internationally accepted credit card.
- 2. All media agencies that require an exclusive booth (5 only) in the media centre will be charged a once only fee of \$500.00 payable in advance to the World Swimming Championships for the use of these facilities.
- 3. Any additional facilities required by the media such as paging services and cellular phones can be provided at additional cost. Please contact Telecom Australia on 09 4207656 for a list of suppliers.



AGENCIES: Five exclusive booths will be provided for media agencies and will include the following facilities. The appropriate tables, chairs and power outlets, two exclusive telephone extensions and a television monitor per booth. Incoming calls can be directly dialled to the telephone extensions by dialling 340 followed by the four digit extension number. Each telephone extension will be equipped with a parallel socket that will allow connection of a compatable data modem for the transmission of computer files.

A once only fee of \$500.00 per booth plus call charges will be applied for these dedicated booths. Booths may be shared if required with the

facility charge shared accordingly.

Agencies will also have access to the shared facilities in the general media area such as the lounge area, television monitors, fax services, telex and the results and information computer terminals.

GENERAL MEDIA: The general media will have shared use of all the facilities in the general media centre. These facilities consist of writing desks, telephone extensions, fax machines, telex services and results and information computer terminals. Television monitors will be conveniently located throughout the centre for your use. Each telephone extension will be equipped with a parallel socket that will allow the connection of a compatable data modem. Telephone handsets suitable for the connection of acoustic coupler modems will also be available.

No charge will be made for the use of shared facilities in the media centre with the exception of call charges.

COMPETITION VENUES

HOST BROADCASTER: A total of twenty booths will be provided by the host broadcaster for television commentary at the Superdrome pool venues. These booths will be equipped with a telephone and have television and results monitors.

AGENCY AND GENERAL MEDIA: A total of two hundred and fifteen (215) additional work areas allocated by A.I.P.S media rating will be provided at the pool venues that will have access to telephones and a results service.

Work areas will be equipped with parallel telephone sockets and have

access to a 240v power outlet.

Media facilities will also be provided at the Women's Water Polo at Bicton Pool and at the start/finish line of the Long Distance Swimming event. These facilities will include access to telephone and fax services.

RADIO: Broadcast positions are controlled by FINA and may be available upon application. For application details please contact the World Swimming Championships Secretariat on 09 3403456. Upon acceptance of your application by FINA please contact Telecom Australia Media Sales on 09 4209512 or write to G.P.O Box J664 Perth 6001. Broadcast positions will have 240v power supplies and will be wired with male Canon three pin sockets and terminal posts.
