ANNEX TO THE WATER POLO CLUB ENTRY FORM 1999-2000

This form has to be read, understood and compiled <u>by all Clubs participating</u> in any of the LEN European Water Polo Club competitions, season 1999-2000, and certified correct by their respective Federations. It has to be returned together with the **Entry Form**. At all stages of LEN Club Competitions from the Qualification Rounds to the Finals, matches are to be played in Swimming Pools which are in conformity with the following Standards:

FIELD OF PLAY

The field of play must have maximum dimensions according to FINA Rules FR 7.2 (for Women FR 7.3). The marking of the field of play should be defined in a clear way.

POOL DECK

From the edge of each of the 4 sides of the pool there must be a <u>minimum space</u> of 2 meters for Referees, Players & Team Staff to have a free way around the pool at any time 60 min. before, during and 30 min. after the match.

STANDS/PUBLIC

There must be a <u>minimum distance</u> of two (2) meters from the first row of the stands to the area which is defined as "Pool Deck". In case the stands are constructed nearer than 4 meters to the edge of the pool, the first row(s) areto be kept free of any public in order to allow an area of minimum 4 meters in between the public and the edge of the pool so guaranteeing that Referees can carry out their duties without any undue physical hindrance.

DRESSING ROOMS

Dressing Rooms for Referees and the Teams should be <u>possibly</u> located in different sections of the pool and have separate access.

AUTOMATIC OFFICIATING EQUIPMENT

- There must be four 35' seconds clocks placed at each corner of the field.
- The main scoreboard showing the time, period, goals and preferably the time left for excluded players is to be placed in such a way as to be clearly visible by the teams, officials on the jury table and public.
- A board displaying the personal fouls of each player is to be placed also in a prominent position, placed either combined with the main scoreboard or adjacent to it, if manually operated.

VARIA

- Other equipment such as spare caps, time clock for the Time Outs, two (2) manual clocks in case of a breakdown of the main scoreboard, whistles, flags for Goal Judges and Jury table etc... are also to be provided.

NOTE: All matches must be played in indoor Swimming Pools!
