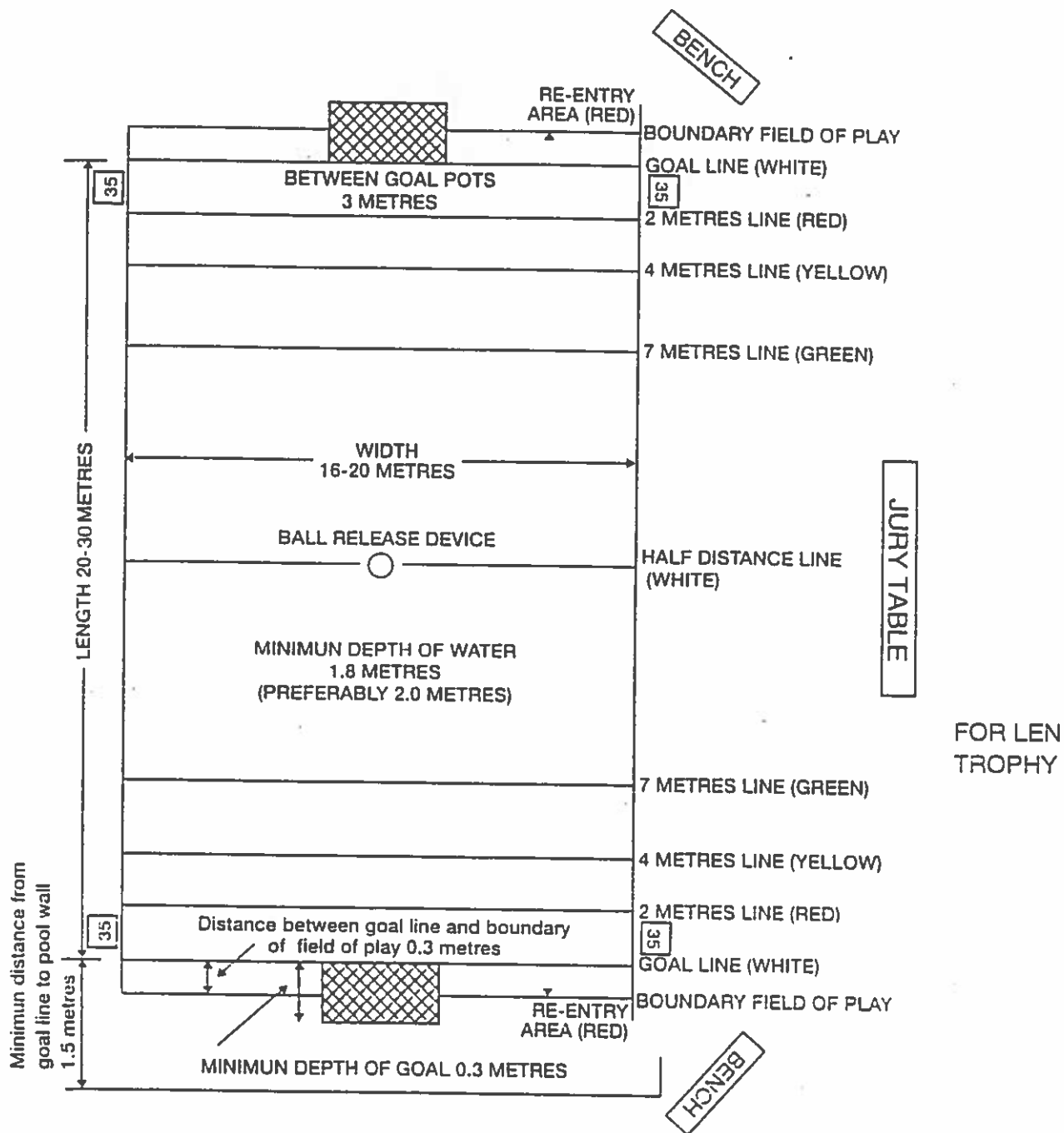

**APPLICATION OF NEW FINA RULES TO BE OPERATIVE FOR
ALL LEN COMPETITIONS AS FROM 1ST OCTOBER 1996**

The following Rules are to be applied as follows until other instructions are issued by FINA. The new rules were discussed at the LEN/FINA Clinic held in Istanbul on the 15/17 August 1997 and later approved by the LEN TWPC.

METHOD OF SCORING - DIRECT SHOT FROM OUTSIDE 7 METRES (WP 15.3)

1. The defensive referee can assist by taking a position near the 7 metre mark, whenever possible, to confirm whether the shot was taken inside or outside the 7 metre area.
2. The shot must be "immediate". Referees may find it helpful to use the same criteria as for the taking of a penalty throw.
3. Clarification of Note to WP.15.3. A goal can be scored by a player immediately shooting from outside 7 metres after his team has been awarded a free throw for a foul committed outside 7 metre. A goal cannot be scored direct if the foul is committed inside 7 metre even if the position of the ball is outside 7 metres.

TIME-OUTS (FINA RULE WP 13.4)

1. The defensive referee should be particularly alert to the possibility of a time-out being called. The new LEN Instruction concerning the position of the coach will be helpful in this respect.
2. At a time-out, a referee should take the ball. Other balls may not be used by the players during a time-out.
3. The timekeeper should make a "warning" sign by whistle 10 seconds before the end of the time-out period.
4. When the players have retaken their positions after a time-out, play shall be restarted from the centre of the field of play with a whistle by the referee. HOWEVER if a time-out is called before the taking of a Penalty Throw or Corner Throw, play shall resume after the time-out with the penalty throw or corner throw.
5. A goal cannot be scored direct from the free throw by which the game is restarted after a time-out.

SIGNALISATION

1. Referees are required to signal the direction of the attack and to point to the place where the ball is to be put into play in the case of a free throw, goal throw and corner throw. This may not necessarily be the same place as where the foul occurred and, in such cases, referees must pay special attention in making the correct signal.

2. In the case of exclusion, the referee shall point to the player and then move his arm towards the boundary of the field of play at the end where the player is to leave the play, before indicating the player's cap number to the player and the table.

TO IMPROVE communication between referees and players (and the table) referees can use both hands to display the players' cap numbers.

SUBSTITUTION

1. After a goal is scored, the referee should not restart the play until he is satisfied that all substitutions have been completed. (WP 16.1)

2. In the case of substitution during the play, the referees should take care not to miss fouls and other incidents while observing that the substitution is made correctly. The secretary is also responsible to ensure that substitutions during play are made correctly (WP 7.2).

OTHER GENERAL GUIDELINES

The referees should meet at least 30 minutes before the start of the game to discuss how to collaborate in the control of the game and to check the field of play and equipment including:

- (a) a full set of white and blue caps, to replace damaged caps;
- (b) two manual clocks, in case of failure of electronic equipment.

After the game, the referees should leave the pool-side together as a team.

Referees can ask the coach, before the start of the game, to co-operate in the case of the 3rd personal foul by ensuring that the excluded player leaves the bench without further intervention by referees.

Change of possession (control fouls) should be emphasised by a change of whistle tone by the referees and by clear hand signals including, if appropriate, the reason for the decision.

At a Neutral Throw a referee shall throw the ball into the water at approximately the same lateral position as the event occurred WP 19.2. Referees are reminded that should the players touch the ball before it reaches the water, there is no foul and play should continue.

The coach is allowed to advance to the half distance line when his team is in attack. However, he must remain at least two metres from the referees and not interfere with his movement. In defence, the coach must immediately return to his bench.
