


Any interested clubs have until the 15th of March to apply for participation.

EXILES SPORTS CLUB

The Exiles Sports Club was founded in 1967 by a group of sports loving students. Since then it has participated at national level in a number of sporting disciplines with varying degrees of success. However, there is one sport with which Exiles is synonymous – waterpolo. The Exiles Sports Club is affiliated with the Amateur Swimming Association of Malta (ASA), the governing waterpolo body in Malta, and has fielded a competitive waterpolo team in Malta's national leagues ever since its affiliation in 1970.

The Exiles Sports Club is located in the busy town of Sliema – a town that is bustling with activity in summer and winter. Its clubhouse, on the water's edge beneath an imposing watchtower built by Grandmaster de Redin in 1758 to protect the Maltese islands from foreign invasion.

Today the club boasts its own premises incorporating a restaurant, changing rooms, sun deck and waterpolo pitch. With its much sought after rocky beaches on either side the club is popular amongst locals and tourists alike.

This year Exiles Sports Club is organising an international waterpolo tournament at Club level, with the full support of the Amateur Swimming Association (ASA), to attract foreign teams to make use of our sporting facilities and learn more about our cultural heritage.

COMPETITION FORMAT

The Exiles International Waterpolo Tournament will consist of two categories of competition - Men's and Ladies. The competition will be played in accordance with the FINA rules applying at the time of competition. Following is the intended tournament format, although this is dependent on the number of teams confirming participation.

Men

Two groups each consisting of six teams with each team playing five matches against the other five teams in the group. A final set of matches will be held on the final day of the competition to decide final team placings across the two groups. Trophies and medals will be presented to the top three placed teams.

All Men's games will be played at the National Swimming complex at Tal-Qroqq in a fresh water pool. This is an international standard swimming complex with all the facilities and amenities expected for a tournament at this level. It is a fresh water facility and is equipped with electronic scoring/timing equipment, multiple changing rooms etc.

Ladies

One group consisting of five or six teams will play in a league format. The winners of the tournament will be the team that places first at the end of the competition. Trophies and medals will be presented to the top three placed teams.

All Ladies games will be played at the Exiles Sports Club in seawater. The Exiles Sports Club is situated within walking distance of the hotel and, besides being used to hold the Ladies' tournament, it will also be made available to all participants for recreation.

ACCOMMODATION PACKAGES

The Exiles Sports Club has negotiated discounted tournament accommodation packages for participating teams. These packages include the following:

- Accommodation for all participants at the four star Galaxy Hotel in a central part
 of Sliema within walking distance of the Exiles Sports Club and the main tourist
 areas for seven (7) nights.
- Transfers to and from Malta International Airport to and from the hotel.
- Transfers to and from all Men's games at Tal-Qroqq. Ladies competition will be held at Exiles Sports Club (within walking distance).
- Breakfast. Half Board and Full Board supplements available as an optional extra.
- Two mid-week social/sightseeing activities to be organised in the evening for all
 visiting teams/delegations (including transport and meals at these events).
- Prize giving/end of tournament reception for all teams/delegations to be held at the Exiles Sports Club.

RATES

All rates are shown in Maltese Lira (Lm) and payments must be made in Maltese Liri, however, we are showing the equivalent US Dollar (USD) rate for illustrative purposes only. US Dollar rate is indicative and based on an exchange rate of Lm 1.00 = USD 2.65 at time of printing.

THE GALAXY HOTEL

All participants will be housed together at the Galaxy Hotel in central Sliema. The Galaxy Hotel is a 4 Star Gold complex situated just 15 minutes walking distance from the entertainment centre of St Julians, 15 minutes from the shopping district of Sliema and 5 minutes from the Exiles Sports Club situated beneath the Sliema/St Julians foreshore promenade.

All rooms in the hotel complex are air-conditioned and equipped with private bathroom facilities, radio, colour television (Satellite reception), direct dial telephone, hairdryer etc. The complex boasts five bars/restaurants; buffet style meals; three swimming pools (one indoor with Jacuzzi, and two outdoor); sundeck; fully equipped gym with computerised cardio-vascular equipment; sauna; squash court; evening entertainment; mini-market; Bureau de Change etc. More details can be found in the accompanying brochure.

FLIGHT ARRANGEMENTS

Flights can be organised through a local travel agency, Sullivan & Sullivan Ltd. Due to the variation of locations of participating teams we have decided to engage this travel agency to organise flight arrangements. Sullivan & Sullivan Ltd are experienced in handling large groups and have associations with travel organisations across Europe. All payments are to be made in Maltese Lira. Full payment will be expected by 30th of May 1998, which is the last day the organisers can release the accommodation booking at the hotel.

REFEREES/TECHNICAL/MEDICAL STAFF

Each team will be expected to provide a qualified referee, to officiate a few tournament matches, at its own expense. There is no limit to the size of each team/delegation. Such person will only be expected to officiate for one match a day.

In addition, each team will be expected to make available a technical official to assist with the time keeping/scoring.

A medical doctor will be available on call throughout the tournament on-site although teams may want to bring their own medical attendant. In addition, an ambulance and trained paramedics will also be in attendance at the National Pool throughout the tournament. Travel insurance is recommended

Each team will be provided with a host/hostess for the duration of the trip.

TRAINING FACILITIES

Since all teams will be involved in competition games on a daily basis we expect that the need for training facilities will be minimal. Open sea facilities (including use of a waterpolo pitch) can be made available at the Exiles Sports Club. If these arrangements are not adequate please let us know so we can organise alternative facilities.

EQUIPMENT

Each team will be expected to provide its own waterpolo balls, two sets of waterpolo caps (blue and white), team pennant etc. Competition balls will be made available by the organisers.

MALTA

We have included with this information pack some promotional material about our beautiful island as well as brochures on the swimming complex, the hotel (Galaxy Hotel) and The Malta Experience (an audio/visual show which we will be taking all participants to watch). We are very proud of our heritage, culture and love of sport. The aim of our tournament is to give you a taste of each of these in a relaxed, friendly yet competitive atmosphere.

EXCURSIONS

Should there be members of the visiting groups wishing to take any of the many excursions available (eg scuba diving, boat trips, historical visits, trips to Gozo/Comino etc) we can make arrangements for such activities. A tournament office will be available within the hotel complex to organise these activities and deal with other enquiries.

IMPACT OF FOOTBALL WORLD CUP

The tournament is being held in the last week of the France '98 World Cup. Like most European countries, Malta is football crazy and is well catered for in terms of television coverage of the World Cup. All games will be shown live on at least two television stations at the same time. All rooms in the hotel are equipped with satellite television receiving channels from all over Europe in a multitude of languages.

We have organised our tournament in such a way to ensure there are no activities or matches that clash with any of the World Cup matches.

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

All commercial Banks provide Automatic Teller Machines (ATMs) which will enable members of the group to withdraw in Maltese Liri against renowned credit cards (eg VISA/Mastercard/American Express). Credit cards are widely accepted and may be used to pay for purchased goods, meals etc. Foreign currency in notes and Travellers Cheques can be cashed anywhere though it is recommended to use banks for the most favourable exchange rates.

Malta is in the Central European Time (CET) timezone and during the tournament the sun rises at 6.00am and set at 9.00pm. The average air temperature at that time of year is a maximum of 25° C and a minimum at night of 14° C.
