Clubs and National Federations may submit, per event in each category:


- a) two (2) Solo with one (1) reserve each
- b) two (2) Duet with maximum one (1) reserve each
- c) two (2) Mixed Duet
- d) two (2) Team of four (4) to eight (8) members with maximum two (2) reserves
- e) two (2) Free Combination of six (6) to ten (10) members with maximum two (2) reserves

During the event, swimmers' substitutions must be indicated on a specific form available at local sport info desk, delivered to the referee 2 hours prior to the competition.



6. SWIMMING POOL



According to FINA

Deviation from FINA:

- Direct finals for every event. No preliminaries are held even if there are more than 13 entries in a session.
- In Free Combination 6-10 competitors were allowed. For entering less than 8 competitors 0,5 points penalty shall be deducted from the total score for each member less than eight.
- In Masters, age groups and gender are divided after the entries if necessary.
- All awards will be given for Technical and Free Routines.

8. SUBMISSION OF THE MUSIC

In accordance with FINA Rules and Regulations Artistic Swimming (AS), section 15.3 (Music Accompaniments).

Method 2, please submit the music via email to the contact address natacao.artistica@fpnatacao.pt.

Each file (MP3 or MP4) should be clearly labelled as below.

Ex) POR Team Technical Routine or POR Team Free Routine





All coaches are highly recommended to have another copy of the music as backup.

9. DRAW

The Insurance of the participants is at the responsibility of respective Federations or Clubs.

12. AWARDS

There will be separate awards for National Championship participants and Open participants.

Medals shall be awarded for the competitors placed first, second and third in each event (including figures) and age group.
